1. Royal BC Museum - www.royalbcmuseum.bc.ca

Come visit one of Canada's leading museums and research centers, with over 550 million years of natural history and 9,000 years of human history. Visit "Our Living Languages: First Peoples' Voices in BC" featuring interactive displays celebrating the resilience of the First Nations languages, to the "Natural History Gallery" that transports you to the forests of BC.

Tour Times: 10:00am or 2:00pm (Booking is required at Delegate Registration on 8th July. Please arrive 30 minutes before tour time.)

Bring: Comfortable footwear & camera

Cost: Free entry with TSL name badge

2. Craigdarroch Castle - www.thecastle.ca

Transporting you back to the Victorian era, Craigdarroch Castle was built for entrepreneurs from the industrial age. Overlooking the city of Victoria, explore what the castle has to offer including one of North America's finest stained glass collections, Richardsonian Romanesque style architecture drawing on influences from France, Spain and Italy, and room settings to match the Victorian era.

Tour Times: 10:00am or 2:00pm (Booking is required at Delegate Registration on 8th July. Please meet at the Canada flagpole at Government House 30 minutes before tour time.)

Bring: Comfortable footwear & camera

3. Beacon Hill / Petting Zoo - www.victoria.ca/EN/main/residents/parks/beacon-hill.html

Visit Beacon Hill for a picnic in the park or a scenic walk through beautiful flowers, unique trees, and small picturesque bridges. Or visit Beacon Hill's petting zoo which brings the farm animal experience into the city. The farm takes pride in providing both an educational and economical form of entertainment while helping children develop a respect for animals. Don't miss the goat stampedes at 10:10am and 5:10pm.

Time: 10:00am – 5:00pm

Bring: Sunscreen, hats, water, light clothes, and comfortable footwear

Cost: Petting Zoo by donation

4. Ogden Point Breakwater - www.victoriatrails.com/trails/ogden-point-breakwater

The breakwater provides an opportunity to see Victoria's busy harbour traffic including cruise ships, ferries, sailboats, float planes, helicopters and more. Wildlife is also commonly spotted, from seagulls to seals, as the fishermen cast their lines from the edges of the breakwater. Look out for the beautifully painted murals of First Nations' history and culture.

Time: Free entry anytime

Bring: Sunscreen, hats, water, light clothes or jacket (dependent on weather), and comfortable footwear
